## 2024 SHS Valedictorian, Salutatorian named

Salado High School Commencement for the graduating Class of 2024 will be 7:30 p.m. May 23 at University of Mary Hardin Baylor Crusader Stadium.

### VALEDICTORIAN

#### PAIGE FARISS

Valedictorian for the class is Paige Fariss, with a final grade point average of 113.5.

Paige is the daughter of Greg and Debra Fariss of Salado. Grandparents are Carol and Bill Britt of Waco and the late Ronald Dansby of Waco and the late David and Diane Fariss of Waco. Her sister Hailey is a junior at Texas State University.

Paige attended Salado schools since Kindergarten.

She participated in University Interscholastic League, competing in Mathematics and Calculator events competing at the state level all four years.

She was an officer in several school organizations including Health Occupation Student Association (HOSA club), Mu Alpha Theta, and the National Honor Society.

She is a member of Salado Youth Leadership, Workforce Industry Training (WIT), and ASTRA.

She competed in volleyball and softball as a freshman and sophomore, and ran on the varsity track team all four years (sprint relays).

"My favorite part of academic and sports meets is spending time and building camaraderie with my friends," she said.

Fariss qualified for the state UIL Math team all four years. Her calculator team placed first in the state in 2023 and she was the overall champion in Calculator at the TMSCA (Texas Math and Science Coaches Association) State Meet across all divisions in 2023. Her team was a state qualifier for the Medical Innovation HOSA event in 2023.

She is a Commended Scholar for the National Merit Program. She received National Rural and Small Town recognition from College Board. She was selected for an intensive summer math program at Duke University where she studied number theory and topology.

She has volunteered at Feed My Sheep, Keep Salado Beautiful, and at the Wellington Rehabilitation and Healthcare Center. She was a Crew Leader at the Salado Methodist Church Vacation Bible School for the past six years.

## Salado gets \$5.5 Mil in fed funds for West Village Rd.

Representative John Carter and Mayor Michael Coggin announced on May 16 that Rep. Carter secured \$5.5 million for west village road development projects in Salado. This funding will increase access and safety in West Salado, one of the

fastest-growing areas of the community. Representative Carter included this funding in the Transportation, Housing, and Urban Development Appropriations bill. The legislation passed both chambers with bipartisan support and was signed into law by

the President.

"Salado is an incredible community, which is why people keep coming to enjoy the charm and friendly atmosphere," said Representative Carter. "With that growth comes challenges, especially to infrastruc-

ture. This \$5.5 million will help the Village of Salado with road development and improvements so the community and its people can continue to flourish. Thank you to Mayor Coggin and his team for being outstanding partners throughout this

process."

"Congressman John Carter continues to provide amazing support to improve the quality of life for the Salado Village community," said Mayor Coggin. "His leadership in Congress brought this \$5.5 million

project to Salado and will dramatically improve future traffic, pedestrian safety, storm drainage and commercial development on the west side of Salado. We deeply appreciate Congressman Carter and his fantastic staff!"

## Sage Kimzey wins PBR Finals

Seven-time PRCA (Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association) champion Sage Steele Kimzey (Strong City, Oklahoma) won the 2024 PBR World Finals in his second appearance at the prestigious event.

"Man, this is special," Kimzey said. "This year's been rough. To come in and cap it off in front of this great crowd, it doesn't get better. Hats off to Cassio Dias. He's an absolute animal. Seeing him come back from injury inspired me. Him winning the gold buckle is no accident."

Kimzey was sensational in Round 1, riding Jersey Tuff (McClellan/Lidgard/Hart) for 89 points, the third-best score of the round. The reserved Oklahoman then stumbled in Round 2, tossed by Army Slasher (Bernard Tallman/Farris) in 1.2 seconds.

Kimzey was then flawless on Championship Sunday. After riding Preachers Kid (K-C Bucking Bulls/RD Cattle) for 91 points in

Round 3, he cemented the World Finals win by covering Let's Roll (Stoltzfus/Bob & Jerry Adams/BS Cattle Co.) for 89.5 points in the fi-

nal round.

The golden finish earned Kimzey \$411,200 and 537 Unleash The Beast points. He concluded the season No.

7 in the Unleash The Beast Standings.

Give parking attendants

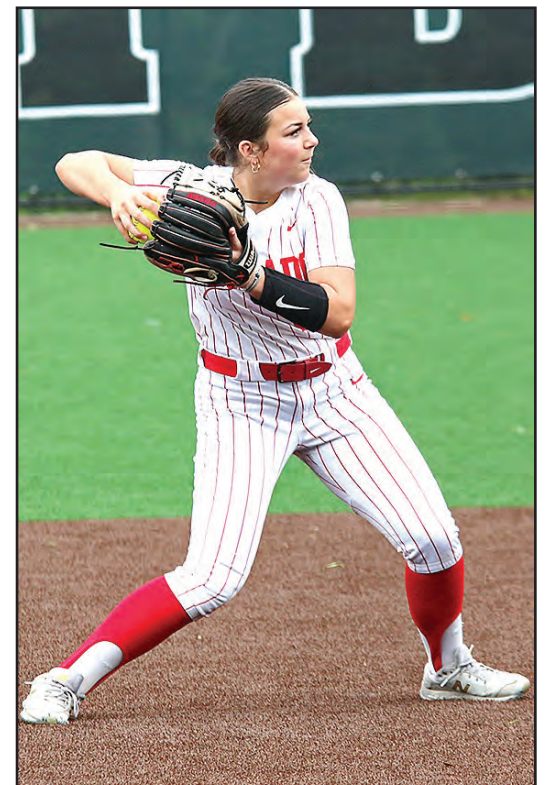
