



First Baptist Church celebrates 160th anniversary

The congregation of First Baptist Church of Salado celebrated its 160th anniversary Sunday, May 26, 2024 during the morning worship service. A beautiful floral arrangement of red, yellow, and white carnations sat on the altar table. The names of the 11 founding members were printed on the front cover of the church bulletin. Their names are Jas. L. Smith, David F. Hair, Harvey Chamberlain, Mrs. Nannie D Reed, Mrs. Nellie We-mott, Mrs. Sarah Hanford, Miss Rachel Austin, Miss Eva Cockrill, Miss Mary L. Cearnals, Miss Nannie Wilkinson, and Miss Sallie Wilkinson.

The service opened with the Sanctuary Choir, under the direction of Robert Pendergraft, majestically singing, O Come, Loud Anthems Let Us Sing.”

During the service, former associate pastor, Scott Mescher, presented the history of the church in time periods pointing out how God had blessed the church during each time period. He began and ended each session by repeating the title of the hymn Great is Thy Faithfulness.

“Fast forward... to a budding town along a creek known for its salty taste, Salado, TX. Various Evangelical groups worshiped at Salado College, in a shared

place, on a rotating schedule. One group of Bible believing people, “resolved that we would take immediately the necessary steps for organizing ourselves into a church proper.” And, in 1864, eleven people organized to form Salado Baptist Church of Christ establishing their identify with 20 Articles of Faith... by the end of same year They called Elder WW Harris to be the first pastor.” Great is thy Faithfulness.

The presentation of the history of the church was followed by the singing of “Shall We Gather at The River.” This beloved hymn was written in 1864, the year the church was founded. This hymn was very appropriate since the church family has gathered hundreds of times during the past 160 years at the river, now known as Salado Creek, for baptismal services.

The morning mes-

sage was delivered by the church's pastor Bill Pinalto. Pastor Bill presented five biblical observations about God's faithfulness.

- Those observations are:
1. God's faithfulness is rooted in His nature, not his mood. (Numbers 23:19; Malachi. 3:6; James. 1:17; Exodus 34:6; I Thessalonians 5:24)
 2. God's faithfulness in the past is meant to be remembered and rehearsed. (Psalms 143: 5; Psalms 77:11-15; I Samuel 12:24, 7:12)
 3. God is presently faithful, even when we are not. II Timothy 2: 3, II Thessalonians 3:3,5)
 4. God's future faithfulness is inevitable because He is eternal. (Deuteronomy 7:9, II Peter 3:8, Psalms 117 1:1-2)
 5. The fact of God's past, present, and future faithful-

Salado Senior Center marks first year of activities

Salado Senior Center will commemorate its first full year of activity with a special luncheon on at 11:30 a.m. June 17. The Salado Senior Center is located in the Youth Activity Center of Salado United Methodist Church, 650 Royal St.

U.S. Census Bureau statistics give us some insight into concerns of the aging senior population. The 2020 census notes that 16.8% of the population, or nearly 56 million senior citizens living in the U.S. This population has grown at a rate nearly five times faster than the total population over the 100 years from 1920 to 2020 and is still increasing. The census also tells us that some 30 percent of seniors are now living alone – up from 13% just five years ago.

Senior centers provide a supportive environment that helps seniors maintain their independence by keeping them busy and staying engaged. Most offer nutrition and health promotion programs as well as information and referrals to other services, activities, and programs in the community. Many are even focal points for benefits enrollment. Finally, senior centers provide social engagement opportunities that are critically important for overall health and wellness.

Since the first senior center opened in the Bronx 76 years ago, more than 10,000

centers across the United States serve more than 1 million older adults each day.

For the past year, Salado Senior Center has served the community. So how did the dream of a Salado Senior Center (SSC) begin? No matter how great an idea, nothing can be created or succeed without a dedicated cadre of people. Fellow seniors, community leaders, generous sponsors and a host of others brought this dream together just one year ago.

The Salado Senior Center got its first steps toward reality more than two years ago when Larry Nathanson, Founder of the Senior Center, started making inquiries to see what interest there might be. He reached out to Dave Swarthout, Director of the Salado Museum at the

time, to explore the possibility of hosting the Center at the Museum. They quickly concluded that the Museum wouldn't be large enough to handle the predicted workload. At about this same time, he reached out to Kim Bird and following a brainstorming session, began to recruit a core group of other Village residents to help. Off to work they went! This team ultimately became the Senior Center's Board of Directors and now includes Kim Bird, Melanie Kirchmeier, Beth Corra, Jeanie Lively, Dave Swarthout and Willie Starnes.

The team went out on the trail for funds, began discussions with the Village, paid visits to other Senior Centers in nearby communities and began to explore possible locations. They drafted a set of bylaws, established

the Board of Directors and identified the structure and roles for the three principal committees that the Center now utilizes. A partnership with the Salado Community Foundation provided an “Umbrella Organization” for the future SSC to operate under as the group began receiving funds and other support. Ultimately, with the help of Mike and Lora Zuber, the SSC was able to obtain its 501c3 non-profit designation.

Reflecting on the effort to make this happen, Nathanson commented, “It was an amazing group of people and local businesses that brought this dream to fruition. They worked extremely hard to solve the problems and developed a plan for us all to follow. Soon it will be time to expand our offerings to three days a week and find a

permanent home!”

What did the first year of the Salado Senior Center look like? A collective effort made up of friends, neighbors, and supporters, the Center opened on June 8, 2023, with a very well attended ribbon cutting and health fair ceremony. The Center draws from a potential population of nearly 1,000 Salado Village seniors, part of the group of more than 3,000 seniors residing in zip code 76571. In its first year of operation, nearly 300 of these residents signed up to participate.

Meeting from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. every Monday and Thursday at the Salado United Methodist Church Youth Activity Center, the SSC offers a full schedule of activities as well as numerous special educational and craft classes. In this first year, the

Center averaged more than 75 participants each day, and is anticipating more than over 5,000 event visits.

What kind of things can visitors do? Come join them for dances, monthly birthday lunch celebrations, holiday specific activities like pumpkin carving, Veterans Day Celebrations and ride the float in the Christmas Parade. The daily schedule continues to evolve and might have just what you want. Do you like games? How about Bingo, Canasta, Dominos, Bridge, Chess, Mahjong or numerous other choices. Maybe you'd prefer crochet, pickle ball, corn hole, Pilates, Tai Chi or a game of pool. You could join the Book Club or Travel Club. Maybe take an Arts & Crafts class, learn about genealogy or computer technology, or sit down with a group of friends and share a few laughs. Just grab a bag of popcorn and some snacks and listen to one of many guest speakers presenting information on helpful topics like Medicare eligibility and fraud prevention.

Jane Avila, Chair of the Activities Committee, worked for hundreds of hours with her team to create a well-rounded and comprehensive program for the SSC participants. Describing her first impressions, Avila noted, “At first it seemed overwhelming, and we thought we would just start with a

few activities to see what everyone seemed to like. Before we knew it, there were two full days of activities lined up and we were off and running!”

In addition to the leadership and guidance provided by the BOD and Committee Chairs, ongoing operations could not have continued without the generosity and time of an amazing cadre of volunteers. These individuals might have focused on a particular event or been part of a team that provided ongoing activities at the Center. Some have taken on roles leading the various Committees, including Tammy Vance with Registration and Linda Crowley and Trish Wiegand with Hospitality. You don’t have to look very far to find J.L. Alley proudly wearing his “Greatest Bingo Caller” t-shirt, hard at work keeping the Bingo games on track. All were trained in CPR, fire and safety management and expected to follow a Salado Senior Center volunteer personnel policy that focuses on customer service, good public relations, confidentiality, and a positive attitude.

The Center’s first year of operation was supported by more than 45 volunteers who provided over 3,000 hours of service.

to understand the value of the Salado Senior Center is to share one of their many success stories. Since meeting a little over a year ago, close friends Jo and Pat tried to stay busy in their apartments with visits, puzzles and sewing. Salado residents and neighbors, both were hoping to find something interesting and fun to do that would give them a chance to become more socially active, make friends, increase their exercise levels, and maintain their health. Through the Senior Center, they found what they were looking for and more. Jo and Pat are now regulars with the Bingo program, making new friends and looking forward to the daily activities that have afforded them the opportunity to get out of the house and feel more productive.

Jo described it best when she proudly commented, “My best friend and I needed a reason to get out of our apartments. Becoming part of the Salado Senior Center gave us that way to change our otherwise dormant days and have something to look forward to each week. These outings have been amazing for us both!”



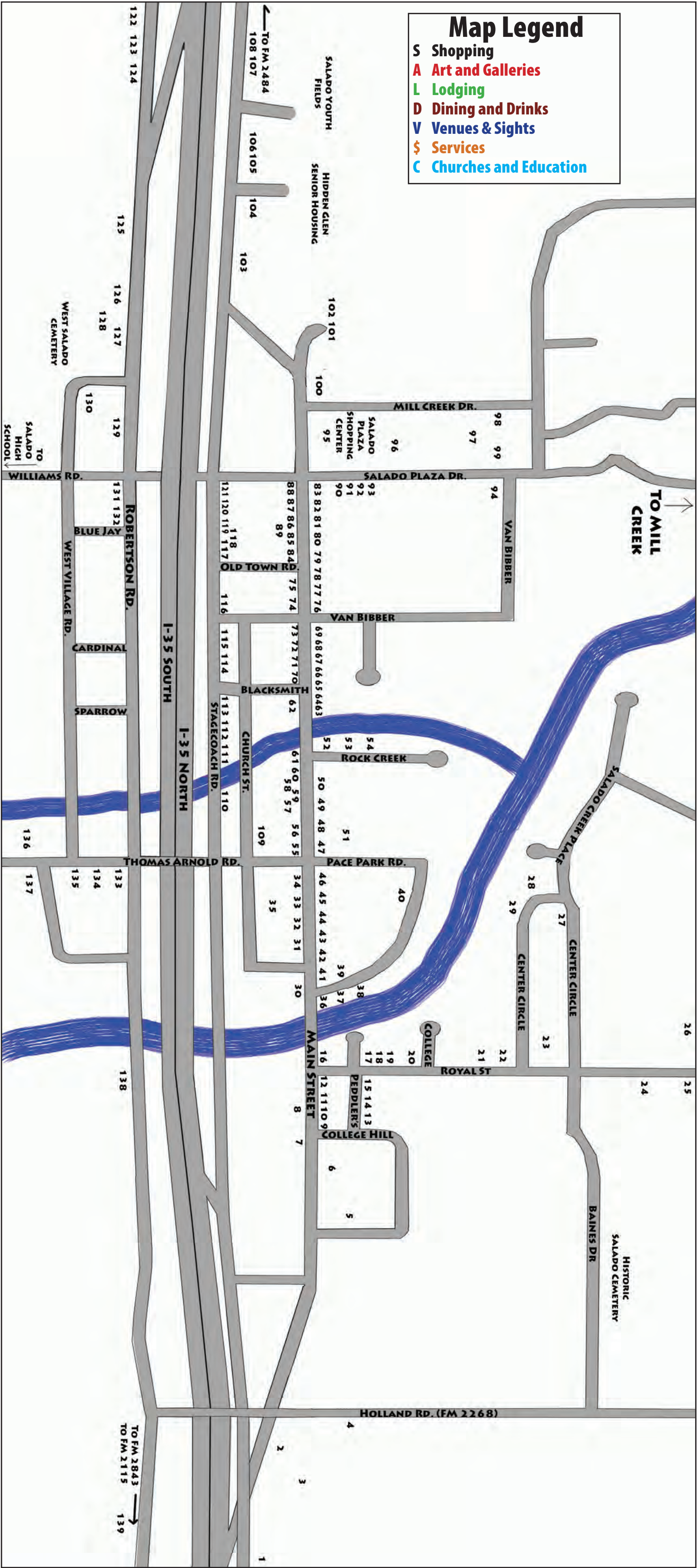

Some would say that the highlight of the service was the ringing of the church bell which was purchased in 1879. The church bell was last rung 10 years ago in May 2014 during the 150th anniversary celebration of the church. Each of the sixteen bell ringers for this special occasion represented a decade in the life of the church. The bell ringers grade level or age and names are as follows:

Church records show that in June 1879, one year after the completion of the first church building, a committee was appointed to secure a bell for the new church. O. T. Tyler served as committee chairman.

The bell, which is bell No. 7, was manufactured by The Goulds Mfg. Co. of Seneca Falls, N.Y. This bell would hang in the cupola of the original church building for the next eighty-three years. When the building was torn down in 1962, the bell was put in storage.

In 1964, when the church built a bell tower memorial to former pastor George Washington Baines, the bell was hung in that tower. In 1990, when the Baines bell tower was demolished to make way for construction of a new building, the bell once again was put in storage. However, on April 23, 2004, during the 140th anniversary celebration of the church, the bell was placed on a new display tower. The bell had found a new home.

As the church family celebrates 160 years of His faithfulness to the church, in and through the lives of the members, it is our prayer that we continue to keep our eyes open, and our ears alert to see and hear what God does next in the life of First Baptist Church of Salado to show us and the world...Great is Their Faithfulness.

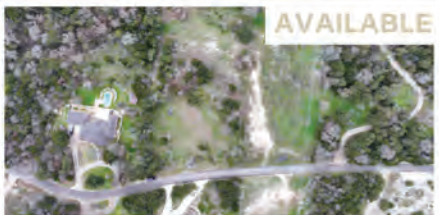



According to Child Find Federal and State regulations, children who meet Texas Education Agency criteria due to one or more of the above delays, and those delays interfere significantly with educational progress in school, may be eligible for early intervention services.
